

FEED MILL MANAGER

Feed mill managers are responsible for overseeing the production, quality, costs and safety of the mill which produces feed for animals.

WHAT RESPONSIBILITIES WILL I HAVE?

- Review production records
- Schedule feed production
- Keep inventory of feed ingredients and order as needed
- Test and review feed/grain quality
- Schedule employee shifts and keep track of employee time
- Handle customer questions and complaints
- Evaluate operating procedures
- Set quality assurance standards
- Prepare and monitor monthly, quarterly and yearly budgets
- Stay up to date on new technology and ways to make process improvements
- Train new employees and provide development opportunities
- Ensure all employees are trained on safety and continue to stay up to date
- Maintain filling equipment and other equipment needed to perform duties such as loaders, scales etc.

A bachelor's degree in agriculture, animal science, poultry science or feed mill management is recommended
